▪ **General Travel Tips for India**

Visa requirements

Visitors also need a valid permit to visit certain restricted/protected areas. They must fill up their Disembarkation/ Embarkation cards on arrival/departure. Foreigners visiting India, who hold long-term visas (more than 180 days), are required to obtain a Registration Certificate and Residential Permit from the nearest Foreigners' Registration Office (FRRO) within 15 days of arrival. The foreigners registered at FRRO are required to report change of their addresses. Certificates of registration issued by the Registration Officers should be surrendered to the immigration officer at the port/check post of exit from India. Passengers embarking on journeys to any place outside India from a Customs airport / seaport are required to pay a Foreign Travel Tax (FTT) of Rs 500 to most countries and Rs 150 on journeys to Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Burma, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka and the Maldives.

**Note:** The above list is subject to change at short notice; please check with the Indian Embassy closest to you before traveling. GMRAA ACI Global Training will provide a letter of invitation upon payment of the registration fee. **Please be sure to obtain your visa well in advance of your departure.**

Health requirements

Before embarking on your India vacation, the foreigners must get familiar with different diseases that are common in Indian climatic conditions.

Local currency Indian Rupee (INR); Indian currency is known as Rupee abbreviated as INR. The Indian money is available in denominations of Re 1, Rs 2, Rs 5, Rs 10, Rs 20, Rs 50, Rs 100, Rs 500 and Rs 1000. Coins are available for Re1, Rs 2 and 1 USD = 50 INR (Subject to Exchange rate).

Foreign Exchange comprising foreign currency notes/coins, traveler's cheques, drafts drawn on banks in India or Bank letters of credit can be brought into India without limit. However, if the total amount of foreign currency notes/coins of travelers cheques brought into India at one time exceeds US\$10,000/- or its equivalent, it is required to be declared by the holder to the Indian customs authorities on arrival on a currency declaration form (CDF). A copy of the CDF duly certified by the customs will be handed over to the declarant. This declaration helps easy

conversion of foreign currency into Indian currency by the tourists and also reconversion of their unspent balances of Indian rupees into Foreign Currency at the time of departure from India. Banks CDFs are available with the Airport/Seaport customs. This will help in exchanging your currency at the time of arrival as well as the taking back your unspent currency at the time of leaving. Money can be easily changed at the airport, some hotels and several branches of International foreign exchange providers.


