OBJECTIVES

- One week recess.
- Four-week on-line session built on the issues addressed in the classroom week and mainly focused on problem- based activities (individual and group assignments)

- The AELP Spring 2017 session will run from April 15 to June 17, 2017 and consists of:
- Three weeks distance learning (commencing April 15, 2017)
- One week classroom session in Munich, Germany, (May 7 to 12, 2017)
- Four weeks of distance learning (May 13 to June 17, 2017)

TUITION FEES

Tuition Fee \$6,200.00 USD (for Members/WBP) payable on acceptance of nomination includes all course material. It does not include travel and accommodation costs for the period in Munich. Students will not be allowed to participate without proof of payment. Non-members may also apply; the fee will be \$7,200.00 USD.

Cancellations must be made in writing as follows: from registration to 30 days before course starting date: 100% minus US\$100 administration fee; from 30 – 15 days before course starting date: 50% minus US\$100 administration fee; from 14 days before course start date: No fees will be refunded.
